

IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE NO. 639

An Ordinance to provide for certain street improvements in the City of Prichard and to provide for assessments of the cost thereof against the properties especially benefited thereby.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Prichard, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. The streets and portions thereof hereinafter designated shall be paved for a width of 10 feet on each side of the center line thereof (said pavement to be 20 feet in total width).

FOCH STREET - Foch Street shall be paved from the east edge of the existing pavement on Graft Highway east to the west line of Pine Street.

EAST PERSHING STREET - East Pershing Street shall be paved from the east edge of the existing pavement on Graft Highway east to the east end of East Pershing Street.

HILL STREET - Hill Street shall be paved from the east edge of the existing pavement on Main Street east to the east end of Hill Street.

CAWTHON STREET - Cawthon Street shall be paved from the west edge of the proposed pavement on Palmetto Avenue east to the west edge of the existing pavement on Telegraph Road.

KATE STREET - Kate Street shall be paved from the east edge of the existing pavement on West Street east to the east edge of the proposed pavement on Section Street.

Section 2. The necessary drainage consisting of Portland cement concrete pipes, and brick catch-basins with cast iron gratings and/or covers, shall be installed as needed along the above described streets and portions thereof. The materials of which said pavement shall be composed are Bituminous pavement on a compacted sand, clay base course.

Section 3. The cost of constructing the improvement provided for in the preceding Section 1 shall be assessed against the properties abutting on the streets and portions thereof herein provided to be improved in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Alabama; provided; that no assessment shall exceed the cost of the improvements and no assessment shall exceed the increased value of the property to be assessed by reason of the special benefits derived from such improvements.

Section 4. The improvements provided for in this ordinance shall be completed in accordance with the established grades on file in the office of the City Clerk of the city and with the details, drawings, plans, specifications, and surveys and cost estimates of said works hereto fore prepared by LADD Engineering Company and on file in the office of the City Clerk of the city of Prichard. The said details, drawings, plans, specifications, and surveys of said work and the cost estimates thereof, which have been exhibited to the City Council, are hereby adopted by said council and shall remain on file in the office of the City Clerk until March 19, 1956 where affected property owners and other interested parties may see and examine the same.

Section 5. The City Council of the City of Prichard will meet on the 19th day of March, 1956 at 5:00 o'clock P. M., in the city hall to hear any objections, remonstrances, or protests that may be made against the improvements provided for herein, the manner of making same, or the character of the materials to be used.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks in The Citizen, a newspaper published in the city in general circulation therein, the first insertion to be at least two weeks prior to March 19, 1956, the date herein set to hear objections, remonstrances, or protests respecting the improvements provided for herein.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to have a copy of this ordinance sent by registered mail, postage prepaid, to each of the persons last assessing the city taxation the property which may be assessed for said improvements, each such copy to be mailed to each such person at his last known address and to be mailed not less than ten days prior to March 19, 1956.
