

ORDINANCE NO. 268

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE ANNUAL CITY AD
VALOREM TAX ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY
EXCEPTING MOTOR VEHICLES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRICHARD, ALABAMA, AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a city ad valorem tax for the tax year commencing on October 1, 1958 and ending on September 30, 1959, is hereby levied for the use of the City of Prichard, Alabama, upon and against each and every parcel of property, whether real, personal, or mixed, and upon and against each and every and all subjects of taxation liable therefor (except motor vehicles), situated in the corporate limits of the City of Prichard, Alabama, and provided further that the levy here made is upon assessments to be made on the State assessments in the manner provided by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama.

Section 2. That the rate of said tax shall be and same is hereby fixed at 1/2 of one per centum of the value of such property and subjects as assessed for State taxation for the tax year provided by the laws of the State of Alabama.

Section 3. That the tax collector of Mobile County, Alabama, shall collect all ad valorem taxes on such property and subjects levied on hereunder, and which are due to the City of Prichard, Alabama, and shall report and pay over the tax money so collected for said City of Prichard, Alabama, at the same time and in the same manner as State and County taxes are reported and paid over by him.

Section 4. That all State laws on municipal taxation applicable hereto be and the same are hereby adopted and made a part hereof as fully as if herein specifically set out.

Section 5. That if any part, clause, phrase, or provision hereof is declared invalid, the rest shall stand, and that this ordinance shall be and become effective on and after its adoption as required by law.
