LEGAL NOTICE

Improvement Ordinance No. 657

An Ordinance to provide for certain street improvements in the City of Prichard and to provide for assessing the cost thereof against the properties especially benefited thereby.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Prichard, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Donna Drive be paved from the North edge of the existing pavement on Whistler Avenue Northward to the South line of Chip Street a width of 20 feet throughout, which is to say 10 feet on each side of the center line thereof.

SECTION 2. That said pavement shall consist of compacted sand-clay base, asphalt prime, asphalt and slag mat and asphalt plant mix seal. The necessary drainage consisting of Portland cement concrete pipes, and brick inlets with cast iron frames and covers shall be installed as needed along the above described street.

SECTION 3. The cost of constructing the improvements provided for the preceding Sections 1 and 2 shall be assessed against the properties abutting on the streets and portions thereof herein provided to be improved in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Alabama; provided; that no assessment shall exceed the cost of the improvements and no assessment shall exceed the increased value of the property to be assessed by reason of the special benefits derived from such improvements.

SECTION 4. The improvements provided for in this ordinance shall be completed in accordance with the established grades on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City and with the details, drawings, plans, specifications, and surveys and cost estimates of said work heretofore prepared by LADD ENGINEERING COMPANY and on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Prichard. The said details, drawings, plans, specifications, and surveys of said work and the cost estimates thereof, which have been exhibited to the City Council, are hereby adopted by said council and shall remain on file in the office of the City Clerk until Nov. 5, 1956 where affected property owners and other interested parties may see and examine the same.

SECTION 5. The City Council of the City of Prichard will meet on the 5th day of November, 1956 at 5:00 o'clock, P.M., in the City Hall to hear any objections, remonstrances, or protests that may be made against the improvements provided for herein, the manner of making same, or the character of the materials to be used.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks in the Prichard Citizen a newspaper published in the City, the first insertion to be at least two weeks prior to Nov. 5, 1956, the date herein set to hear objections, remonstrances, or protests respecting the improvements provided for herein.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to have a copy of this ordinance sent by registered mail, postage prepaid, to each of the persons last assessing for City taxation the property which may be assessed for said improvements, each such copy to be mailed to each such person at his last known address and to be mailed not less than ten days prior to November 5, 1956.
