AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING, AFFIRMING AND EXTENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 1406

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Prichard, Alabama (herein called the "City") as follows:

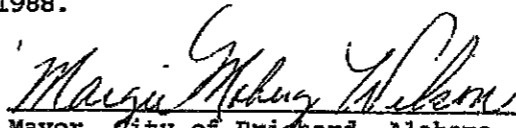
Section 1. The City hereby ratifies and affirms Ordinance No. 1406, approved and adopted on the 2nd day of December, 1975. The rights, privileges, authorities and franchises granted thereunder shall be extended to September 1, 2018 and shall continue in full force and effect until said date.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published at the expense of the Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Prichard in one issue of The Mobile Press Register, a newspaper published in Mobile County and having a general circulation in the City (there being no newspaper published in the City having such circulation), and shall become effective upon such publication.

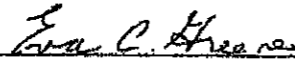
Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions or orders or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 583

An Ordinance Granting a Sewer Franchise to the City Water Works and Sewer Board of The City of Prichard, Its Successors and Assigns.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRICHARD, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That Ordinance No. 583 adopted and approved on June 15, 1953, be and the same hereby is repealed.

(2) The words "the City" as used, herein mean the City of Prichard in the State of Alabama, as it is now constituted and as it may hereafter be extended or enlarged.

(3) The words "the Board" as used herein mean the Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Prichard, as such corporation organized under the provisions of the Code of Alabama of 1940, Title 37, Sections 394-402, whose certificate of incorporation has been amended pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 175, adopted at the 1951 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama.

(4) There is hereby granted to the board the right, privilege, authority and franchise to acquire, own, maintain, construct, enlarge and operate in the city a sanitary sewer system, together with the right, privilege, authority and franchise to lay, construct and maintain mains, laterals, sewers (including outfalls), and related fixtures and appurtenances in, along, across and under the streets, avenues, alleys and other public places of the city for the purpose of operating a sanitary sewer system in the city, and to repair, renew, relay and extend such mains laterals sewers and related conductors, fixtures, and appurtenances, and to make all excavations necessary therefor.

(5) The right, privilege, franchise and authority hereby granted may be exercised by the board or any successors and assigns of the board all subject nevertheless to the conditions, and obligations herein contained.

(6) The right, privileges, franchise and authority hereby granted shall be in full force and effect for a period of thirty years from such effective date.

Section 4. The rights, privileges, authorities and franchises hereby granted shall continue in force and effect for a period of thirty years from the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance are intended to be severable and, if any one or more thereof should be held invalid for any reason, the rest shall nevertheless stand and be fully effective.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be published at the expense of the Board in one issue of The Mobile Press Register a newspaper published in Mobile County and having general circulation in the City (there being no newspaper published in the City), and shall become effective upon such publication.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions or orders or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
