

ORDINANCE NO. 1794

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS OF CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRICHARD, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Any person applying for or holding an office, position or employment of the City of Prichard, Alabama, subject to the Civil Service Act of Mobile County, Alabama, (Local Act No. 470, approved September 15, 1939, Local Acts of Alabama, page 298, as amended) must be a resident of the City of Prichard, Alabama, or its police jurisdiction; provided, however, that the classified position of Electrician II of the City of Prichard is excepted from the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. Any person applying for or holding the classified position of Electrician II of the City of Prichard must be a resident of Mobile County, Alabama, and must have been such a resident for a period of at least three years of the five years next preceding the date he applies for such position.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or resolutions heretofore passed regulating residence requirements of employees of the City of Prichard are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall have full force and effect upon its approval as required by law.
