

ORDINANCE NO. 581

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRICHARD, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That a City ad valorem tax for the tax year commencing on October 1, 1953, and ending on September 30, 1954, is hereby levied for the use of said City of Prichard upon and against each and every motor vehicle situated in the corporate limits of said City, and provided further that the levy here made is upon assessments to be made on the State assessment in the manner provided by the Constitution and law of the State.

SECTION TWO: That the rate of said tax shall be and same is hereby fixed at one-half of one per centum of the value of such motor vehicles assessed for state taxation during the same tax year.

SECTION THREE: That the Tax Collector of Mobile County, Alabama shall collect all ad valorem taxes on motor vehicles levied here under and which are due to City of Prichard, Alabama, and shall report and pay over the tax monies so collected for said city at the same time and in the same manner as state and county taxes are reported and paid over by him.

SECTION FOUR: Be it further ordained that all state laws on municipal taxation applicable hereto be and the same are hereby adopted and made a part hereof as fully as if herein specifically set out.

SECTION FIVE: That if any part, clause, phrase, or provision here of is declared invalid, the rest shall stand, and that this ordinance be and become effective on and after its adoption.
